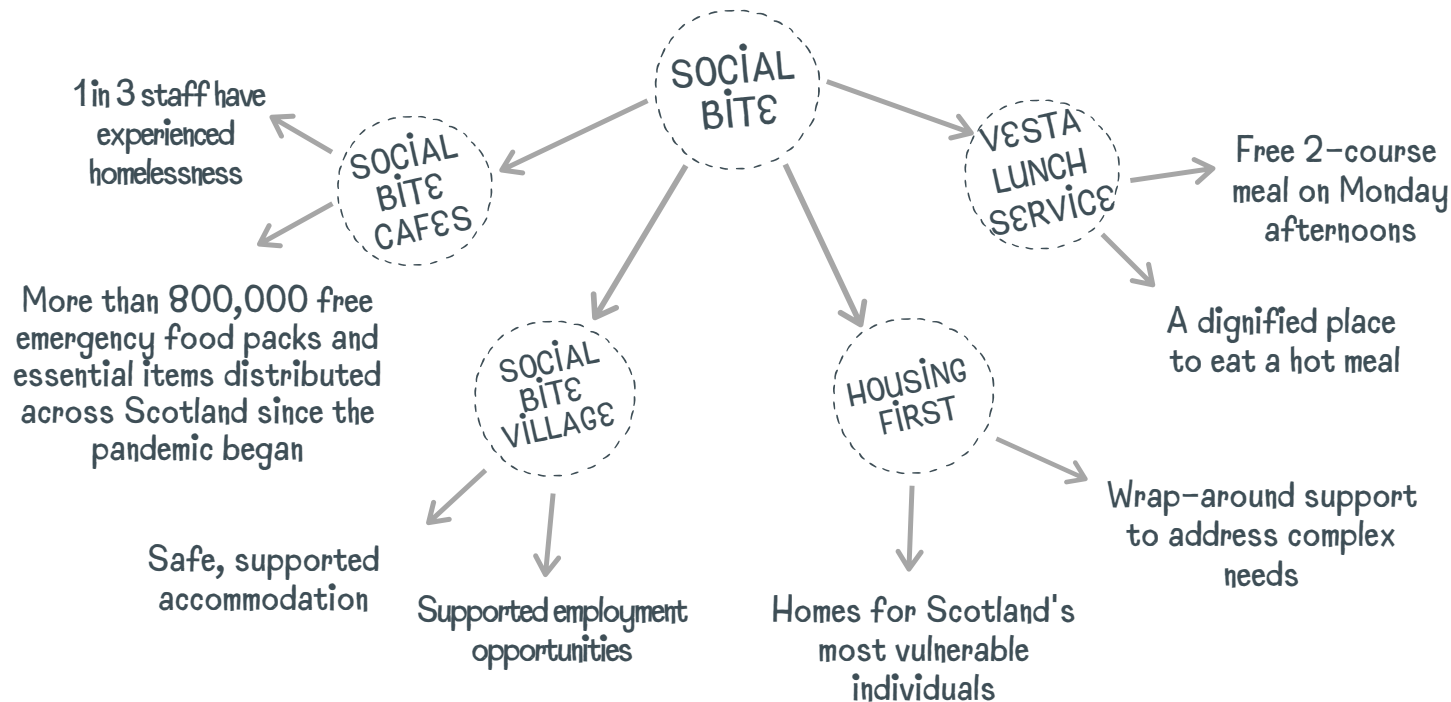
A visit to Vesta is more than just a great meal. We're also a restaurant with a difference. Together with Social Bite, we're on a mission to end homelessness in Scotland.

ABOUT SOCIAL BITE

Social Bite first began as a sandwich shop in Edinburgh in 2012. Its co-founders, Josh Littlejohn MBE and Alice Thompson, decided to operate as a Social Business by giving away all profits to good causes.

Since then, Social Bite has focused its mission on ending homelessness here in Scotland and now employs more than 70 people across their four social enterprise sandwich shops in Scotland, as well as their Central Kitchen Unit in Livingston and with us, their partner restaurant, Vesta Bar & Kitchen.

Social Bite uses profits to champion the mission of ending homelessness and has pioneered some incredible programmes along the way, including the Social Bite Academy which provides supported employment for people experiencing homelessness, the Social Bite Village where up to 20 individuals live at any one time and Housing First Scotland, which provides permanent homes to Scotland's most vulnerable individuals - so far more than 500 people have been housed.

Social Bite has successfully led mass campaigns such as Sleep in the Park and inspired the world to do the same with The World's Big Sleep Out. So far more than 80,000 people around the world have taken part raising more than £20M in the process.

All this and more has been made possible thanks to people joining the movement and calling for an end homelessness.
